	Traffic impact monitoring (Mill Road and surrounding roads)
Highways - Govia	Discount Taxis Fares for elderly and less mobile sponsored by Govia
	Shuttle buses
Highways - Petersfield	Ditchburn place should be a place to turn buses around
	Restrict Taxi Movements
	Restrict Traffic in Devonshire Rd and Tennyson Rd
Highways – Romsey & Petersfield	Organise and Mark Up Turning Circles
	Organise event centres on Mill Road in Romsey and Petersfield, closing the whole road Fri - Sun, e.g. Cavendish-Thoday
	White Lines defining Single Track with Parking Places, Delivery and Loading Bays, and a wider footway
